Create a mini masterpiece with this crafty bookmark. The application of color allows you to create a unique piece, perfect as a gift or to keep for yourself.

Materials Needed

Legacy L-PLD70 Craft Web Sheets	1 Sheet
Legacy L-987 Fusible Fleece White	25cm
Printer Paper	1 Sheet
Fabric Crayons	
Stamp of choice	
Black ink	
Yarn	

Tools Needed

6mm (1/4") Hole Punch
Rotary cutting tools and supplies
Scissors

Assembly

Step 1. Cut one 3" x 6" rectangle of Craft Web and Fusible Fleece. Cut one 2½" x 6" rectangle of printer paper.

Step 2. Color the 2½" x 6" rectangle of printer paper with fabric crayons.

Step 3. Place the colored paper on top of the Craft Web. Iron the colored paper.

Remove the paper.



Step 4. Place the colored Craft Web dull side down on the Fusible Fleece.

Fuse following manufacturer's instructions. Cut the Fusible Fleece to 2½" x 6".



Step 5. Stamp it.

Step 6. Punch a hole in the center of the bookmark using the hole punch.

Step 7. Cut yarn to desired size. Put strands together and pull through the hole making a loop. Thread the yarn through the loop and pull gently.

Cut ends to desired length.
