

## Half Square Triangle Quilt Made with Charm Packs Skill Level: Beginner



Charm Packs are accurately cut at 12.7cm (5") square and normally come in packs of 42. The "half square triangle" is a commonly used unit in quiltmaking and is easily mastered. Beginning quilters of all ages will gain confidence and achieve success quickly while learning basic lessons on stitching together triangles and squares to create this very graphic design. Example shown is 84cm x 84cm (33" x 33") with 10.5cm (4 1/8") finished blocks. Sample used fabrics from Spotlight.



## **Tools Needed**


Sewing machine and related tools Rotary cutter and related supplies



Step 1. Place one dark square and one light square right sides together with the light square on top. Place a ruler from point to point as shown in diagram. Draw a line along the edge of the ruler.




Step 2. Stitch 1/4" from the drawn line as shown below:



Step 3. Cut on the drawn line. Press seam toward the dark triangle.


Step 4. Repeat Steps 1 through 3 for remaining squares. Refer to the chart on Page 3 for number of squares for desired quilt size.

Step 5. Assemble quilt following instructions on Page 3. The quilt is assembled in four quadrants. Each quadrant is made of rows of squares. Refer to the diagram and chart on Page 3 for placement.



## Assembling The Quilt

This quilt is constructed from four quadrants. Sew rows of squares as shown below. Refer to the chart for number of squares in each quadrant. Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams for each row in opposite directions.

Step 6. Measure quilt vertically and horizontally. Cut backing and batting to fit. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind quilt.
