What dad would not be proud to receive this for Father's Day? Use Lutradur® to make this quick and easy mug rug for the special dad in your life. This is an excellent and fun project for children and mothers to make together. Finished mug rug is 8" x 10". Sample was made by Charlene Allison, age 12.

Fabrics Needed

Light cotton fabric for background
Scraps of bright cotton fabrics for stripes
Cotton fabric for the backing

One 21.6cm (8-1/2") square
Eight 3.8cm x 6.24cm (1½" x 2½") rectangles of various colors
One 21.6cm x 26.7cm (8½" x 10½") rectangle

Materials Needed

Legacy L-FB-96 100% cotton batting
Legacy L-PLD70 Craft Web Sheets
Legacy L-805 Fuse-Under™
Thread
Fabrigo® fabric pens

One 21.6cm x 26.7cm (8½" x 10½") rectangle
One 21.6cm (8½") square
One 21.6cm (8½") square

Various colors

Tools Needed

Sewing machine and related supplies
Rotary cutter and related supplies (children should be supervised)

Step 1. Print template found on the template page.

Step 2. Trace the letter templates onto the paper side of the Fuse-Under™.

Step 3. Place the fusible side of the Fuse-Under™ against one side of the Craft Web Sheet. Fuse following manufacturer's instructions.



Step 4. The lettering on the Fuse-Under™ should show through the Craft Web Sheet. Trace the lines onto the Craft Web Sheet if necessary. Color the letters in using the Fabrico® fabric markers on the Craft Web Sheet. Let dry.



Step 5. Iron the letters to heat set them. Cut letters out using sharp scissors. Remove the paper backing.

Step 6. Arrange letters as desired. onto the 8½" square of cotton fabric. Fuse into place following manufacturer's instructions.

Step 7. Place two 1½" x 2½" rectangles right sides together and stitch one 2½" side using a ¼" seam allowance. Press seam in one direction.

Step 8. Repeat until all eight rectangles are sewn together.



Step 9. Place the rectangle section right sides together on the right side of the applied block aligning raw edges. Stitch using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam toward the applied block.



Step 10. Place the back and the front of the mug rug right sides together. Place the batting on top of the back of the mug rug. Pin to hold. Stitch around entire perimeter of mug rug, leaving a 4" opening on the end of the applied block.

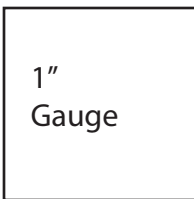
Step 11. Trim all four corners at a slant to reduce bulk.



Step 12. Turn mug rug right side out through the opening. Topstitch around entire perimeter, right on the edge and again $\frac{1}{4}$ " in from the previous stitching.
